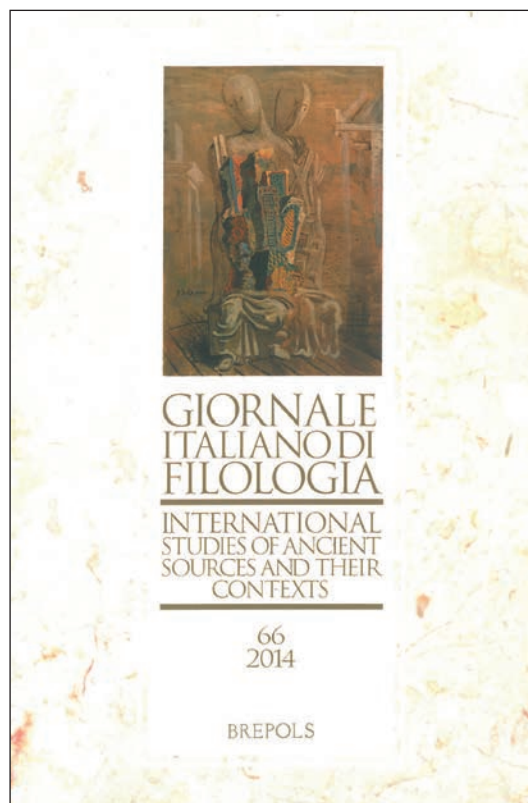

Marmorale, is an Italian international journal of studies in philology, considering all the accepted meanings of the word and all facets of this utmost interdisciplinary subject. The journal may therefore include contributions from linguists, historians, experts of antiquities, editors and exegetes of texts. Contributions cover the Greek and Roman world up to the Latin Middle Ages and may include forays into Romance Philology. Brepols Publishers has taken over the publication of the *Giornale* starting from its 65th volume.
