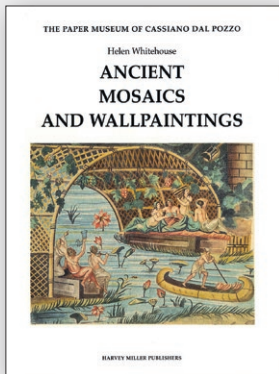

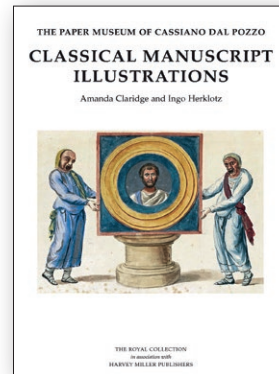


Ancient Mosaics and Wallpaintings

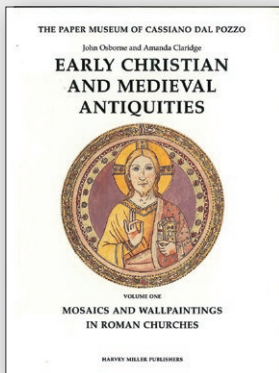


Classical Manuscript Illustrations

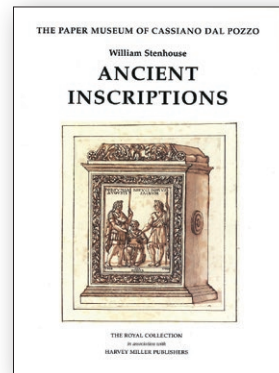

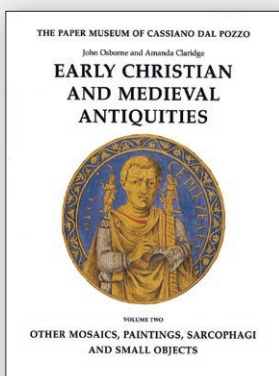


Ancient Inscriptions

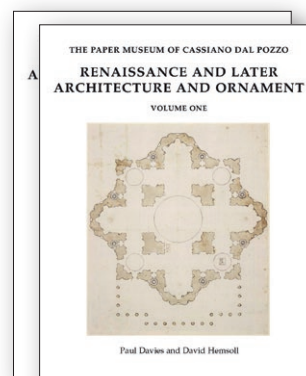

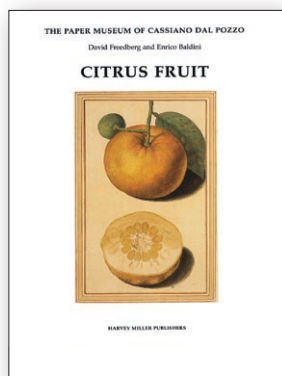

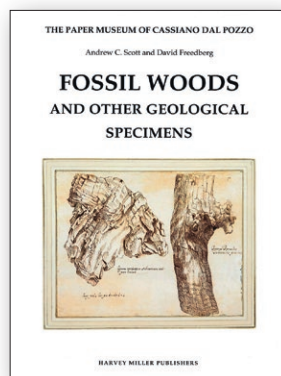
Citrus Fruit

The volume catalogues a group of 118 drawings of citrus fruit in water-colour and gouache, most of which were commissioned by Cassiano to illustrate Giovanni Battista Ferrari's *Hesperides*, an ambitious attempt at a complete taxonomy and classification of the entire citrological world, which was published in Rome in 1646.

The close to 200 early seventeenth-century drawings catalogued in this volume were commissioned by Federico Cesi and constitute the first truly scientific study of fossilised woods. Later acquired by Cassiano, the unusually accurate and impressive drawings also include depictions of animal fossils, ammonites, pyrites and baked clay.

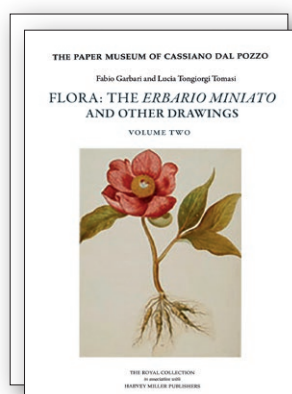
Fungi

These three volumes catalogue the extensive corpus of almost 600 mycological drawings in the Paper Museum. Most were executed between 1625 and 1630 for Federico Cesi and the Accademia dei Lincei before being acquired by Cassiano. They depict fungi native to Umbria and the environs of Rome and constitute the first sustained attempt to survey all the larger fungi of a region, recording in detail the stages of their growth.

The *Erbario Miniato* and other Drawings

These two volumes catalogue more than 200 botanical drawings from an early seventeenth-century herbal made for Federico Cesi and acquired by Cassiano after Cesi's death in 1630. Most of the drawings depict the native flora of central Italy, but mycological specimens, rarities from across Europe and recently imported species such as the crown imperial, the tobacco plant, the tomato and the aubergine are also represented.

The 'Museo Cartaceo' ('Paper Museum') is a collection of some 10,000 watercolours, drawings and prints, assembled during the seventeenth century by the Roman patron and collector Cassiano dal Pozzo and his brother Carlo Antonio. It represents one of the most significant attempts before the age of photography to embrace human knowledge in visual form. The collection documents ancient art and culture, architecture, zoology, botany, geology and social customs, and provides us with a major tool for understanding the intellectual concerns of a period during which the foundations of our own scientific methods were established. The *catalogue raisonné* gives unprecedented access to this major source of reference for the intellectual, cultural, artistic and scientific history of seventeenth-century Europe.
