In total, 236 editors from 20 different countries have contributed to this unique and large-scale enterprise, which started its first volume in 1989 and consists of seven volumes – including a fifth volume in two parts – and a supplement.

Aristoteles Latinus Database (ALD)

The *Aristoteles Latinus Database* aims at documenting the various tools that were used in the Middle Ages for the study of Aristotle, with a special emphasis on Latin translations. The first release of the database (ALD-1/2003) consisted mainly of the Greco-Latin translations in the printed *Aristoteles Latinus* series and also in some unpublished editions in preparation. In the second release (ALD-2/2006), this corpus of translations was further expanded with texts that had been edited within other contexts (such as the *Editio Leonina* of Thomas Aquinas's works). The third release adds many new texts to this corpus, nearly doubling its volume, and in doing so, widens its scope. Not only does it add several previously unavailable Greco-Latin Aristotle translations, it also includes other texts that have shaped the study of the Latin Aristotle in the Middle Ages. The database has received a major update: alongside the newly added *Physiognomonica* as translated by Bartholomew of Messina (ed. L. Devriese, 2019) and Books VI-X of *De historia animalium* as translated by William of Moerbeke (ed. P. Beullens & F. Bossier, 2021), the ALD also pilots an improved data organization and user interface. These innovations allow for closer integration with the *Database of Latin Dictionaries* and will gradually be implemented for the other Latin full-text databases on Brepolis too. At present, the *Aristoteles Latinus Database* contains more than 2.3 million Latin words, drawn from 110 works that are attributed to 45 authors.
