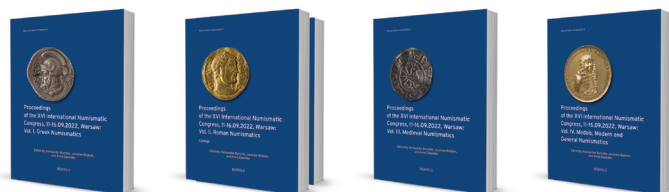

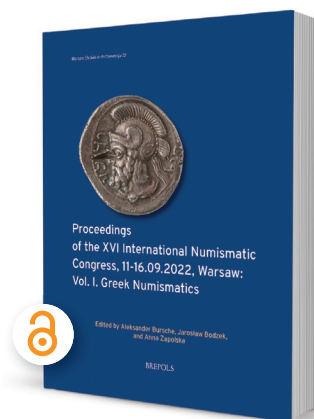
Volume I Greek Numismatics

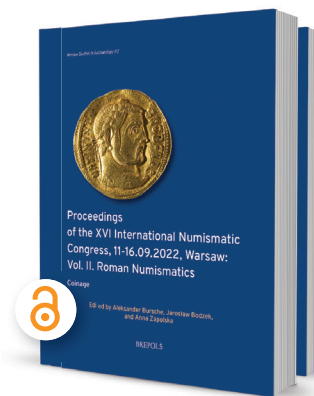
Volume II Roman Numismatics

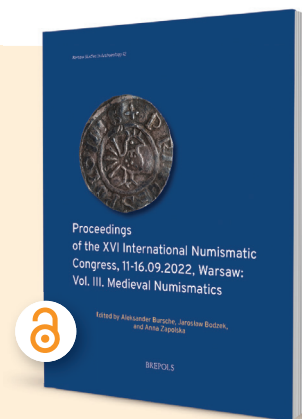


Volume III Medieval Numismatics
